DEADLINE

There is no formal deadline, but we recommend you apply at least 10-12 weeks before the program starts to ensure enough processing time for your F-1 visa. We accept applications until the program is full.

PROCESSING TIME

Once we receive a complete application, we will send you an Acceptance Letter, program information, housing information, and I-20 via DHL Express Mail within one week.

ENROLLMENT DEPOSIT (For ACP students only)

To confirm enrollment, students admitted to an ACP are expected to pay a deposit of \$3,000, which will be deducted from tuition. The deposit is due at least 30 days before the program start date.*

*This policy does not apply to students admitted to ACP TEFL.

POSTPONEMENT POLICY

Postponement requests must be made in writing to ip@ce.uci.edu according to the following:

- » Within 16 calendar days of the program start date for the 10-Week program
- » Within 14 calendar days of the program start date for Certificate programs
- » Within 7 calendar days of the program start date for the 4-Week programs

No additional charge for the first postponement. Additional postponements after the first require a new \$200 application fee.
